

Liturgical Ministers

February 2009 Refresher Training

Mass Coordinators:

For the 9:00 and 11:00 masses, the mass coordinator does **not** assist as a Eucharistic Ministers. For the 5:30 mass the mass coordinator can be the Eucharistic Minister.

Please insure that all Eucharistic cups are purified.

At the sign of peace the mass coordinator should not be greeting others while holding the Ciborium containing the consecrated Eucharist. This has happened on occasion.

Mass coordinators note below the positioning for station four.

Lectors:

No need to bow as you approach the Ambo.

Please pause after the reading and before pronouncing, "The Word of God."

Eucharistic Ministers:

It is flu season so please make an extra effort to wipe clean the cups after each person receives the Precious Blood. Please open the purificator and change the position of the purificator as you clean the cup.

Do remain at the foot of the altar until all ministers have received the Body and Blood of Christ. Then proceed to the altar.

The proper positioning for station one ministers moving to station four is the two "Body Ministers" stand next to each other and the four "Blood Ministers" stand next to each other.

B-B C-C-C-C

Only one "Blood Minister" is needed to carry the cups to the credence table. Please make sure to purify the cups by adding a small amount of water to the cups and consolidate the water into a single cup. There is no rush and purification is required to assist the presider and/or deacon.
